-**Bib numbers cannot be collected on the day of the race**.

-If you are unable to collect your bib number in person, **another person** **ay collect it on your behalf showing a signed** authorisation and the necessary documentation (photocopy of the runner's official ID document and proof of registration).





After crossing the finish line, the runners will receive their **finisher medal**, as well as refreshments and physiotherapy services. These services will be provided at the roundabout.

Once crossing the finish line, we advise the runners **to walk to the post-finish line area, located in front of the Noble Hospital.**



We request the runners to move away from the finish line area due to the large number of participants. Once you cross the finish line, in order to avoid crowds, we recommend that you go to the baggage drop area to collect your belongings.

We remind you that, for safety and logistical reasons, the finish line area will only be open to participants.

INTRUCTIONS

- Only **one bag** per runner will be allowed.
- Travelling luggage or large items (max. 5kg) will not be accepted.**
- Each participant will be given a **sticker at the baggage drop**; one part of this sticker must be attached to their bib number and the other one to their bag.
- Runners must label their bag with **this sticker and then hand it over**, showing their ID to our volunteers.
- To collect your bag from the baggage drop service, **you must show your bib number with the sticker attached.**
- We strongly advise you not to leave delicate or valuable items in your bag. The organisers will not be responsible** for any loss or damage these items may suffer due to handling by our team of volunteers.

HOW TO GET TO THE EXIT

CITY BUSES

The Malaga Transport Company (EMT) offers **45 bus routes** with an average **frequency of 10-15 minutes**.

All runners will receive two return tickets in their runner's bag, to be used on the **14th of December 2025, between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.** (valid on all EMT lines except for the airport).

MALAGA'S UNDERGROUND

Malaga's Underground has **two lines** with an average **frequency of 10 minutes**.

The Atarazanas station is the closest to the starting area, about 200 metres away, right on Alameda Principal.

HOW TO GET TO THE RUNNER'S EXPO

The organisation will provide a shuttle bus service for the participants, running directly between the surrounding area of the Pompidou Centre and the Port of Malaga Cruise Terminal.

This service will run **every 20 minutes** throughout the duration of the Runner's Expo:

MEDICAL SERVICES



The 16 drink stations along the route will be located **every 2 kilometres** and also at the start/finish line, where the first-aid point and ambulances will be stationed.

From these facilities, **medical services** will be able to quickly respond to any incidents involving participants or members of the public attending the event.



Physiotherapy services will be available for our participants at the Pompidou area, next to the baggage drop and along the race.

As a complementary service, **SOS Cardiosport and members of Proteccion Civil will ensure the well-being of the runners of the GENERALI Malaga Marathon** with their mobile medical assistance teams, which will be available throughout the race.

In addition, the city of **Malaga has an extensive network of automatic external defibrillators (AED)**, with the objective of keeping the city covered. The organisers of the GENERALI Malaga Marathon have compiled this table showing the devices closest to the circuit.

DRINK STATIONS



Please note that the drink stations, like all the other race services, **are only available to runners participating with a bib number of the GENERALI Malaga Marathon or GENERALI Malaga Half Marathon.**



No other vehicle will be allowed to participate in the race, only those accredited by the organisation.

PACERS

The organisation will provide pacers running at a suitable pace to complete the course.

The times set by these athletes will be: **3h, 3:15h, 3:30h, 3:45h, 4h, 4:15h and 4:30h.**

They will also set half marathon paces in **1:30h; 1:37, 1:45, 1:52, 2, 2:07 and 2:15.**

The pacers in charge of this task will be properly identified by their clothing and with recognisable flags.

TOILETS

Toilets for participants will be provided by the organisers at the **start/finish area, as well as at all drink stations.**

CUT-OFF TIME



The cut-off time for the race has been established at 14:20, which is the official maximum time for completing the course regardless of the start time.

RESULTS

The results of the GENERALI Malaga Marathon will be published on the race website, www.generalimaratonmalaga.com, after the end of the race and after the revision by the official judges of the Andalusian Athletics Federation and the Spanish Athletics Federation.

PRIZES



A trophy ceremony will be held at the Eduardo Ocón venue for the **overall men's and women's categories** (marathon and half marathon), **mixed wheelchair category** (marathon), **mixed physically/intellectually disability category** (marathon), **first Spanish man and woman** (marathon) and **first man and woman with a Malaga running license**.

There will be no trophy ceremony for the different age groups (marathon). There will be an identification point for winners at the Eduardo Ocón venue to check the identity of the runner **(by means of any official ID document)**. Winners may then access the stage to collect their prize and must leave the area once they have done so.

VOLUNTEERS

Several associations will be volunteering at the GENERALI Malaga Marathon 2025. In total, there will be more than **1,100 volunteers** helping the runners and making sure everything goes smoothly. Don't forget to thank them for their incredible work.

SUSTAINABLE EVENT



The **GENERALI Malaga Marathon 2025** wants to be an **environmentally friendly event**, and to achieve this, the cooperation of each and every participant is essential. Therefore, we would like you to have this information in order to facilitate your cooperation:

At the drinks stations, **there will be specific bins for recycling:**

-At the drinks stations with just water, there will be **YELLOW** bins for the disposal of water bottles. They will be located approximately 100 metres away from the last table and on both sides of the road. If you decide to keep the bottle with you beyond the 100-metre mark, you must keep it with you until the next station. In any case, they must always be thrown in the bin and **NEVER** on the ground.

-At the combined drinks stations, there will be:

YELLOW bins for disposing water and sports drinks bottles. They will be located approximately 100 metres away from the last table and on both sides of the road. If you decide to keep the bottle beyond the 100-metre mark, you must keep it with you until the next station. In any case, they must be thrown in the bins and **NEVER on the ground.**

Grey bins for disposing fruit waste. They will be located behind each table with fruit, making it easy to throw them away after consumption.

At the finish line, there will be yellow and grey bins behind the drinks stations for the same purpose. If you decide to discard your poncho, this plastic waste must also be thrown into the yellow bin.

Bottles should be thrown into the yellow bin and fruit waste into the grey bin.

Any waste must be thrown into the bins and **NEVER on the ground.**

Respect for the environment: The race passes through urban areas that must be respected for the benefit of everybody.

Bib number collection:

Bib numbers and T-shirts can only be collected at the Runner's Expo, which will be held in Terminal B of Malaga's Port.

As the run takes place on Saturday 13th of December at noon, **bib numbers and T-shirts must be collected on Friday 12th of December between 10 am and 8 pm.** Under no circumstances will bib numbers and T-shirts be available for collection on Saturday 14th of December.
